SWIMMING POOL OF CHIOS "IONIKON"

COMPETITION POOL: 50m Indoor This sport complex, with a capacity of 3.000 spectators. The indoor competition swimming pool is a 50 meters and 10 lanes pool with 2,05-2,20 meters debth, and average temprature 260 +_10 C.

> The complex also include: Four groups of dressing rooms. Each group has adequate space for 100 persons with: showers, toilets, massage and rest rooms, dressing rooms for officials, separate from athletes. It also includes numerous rooms for preparation, meetings, victory ceremonies, preparations and cafeteria.





GENERAL INFORMATION

The Championship will take place in IONIKO Swimming Pool, Chios, Greece from $17^{\rm th}$ to $24^{\rm th}$ June 2025.

Information about Participation

- Only participants with a CMAS license are eligible to Compete in the Championship.

- All participants should respect the championship rules, the safety conditions set by the organizers and CMAS rules and regulations.

Swimming Pool Events

- Each country may enter no more than two (2) swimmers for each individual event and one (1) team per relay event.

- For relay races the names of the swimmers and their starting order must appear in a list submitted to the results office before the start of the session. The composition of mixed relays is with two (2) males and two (2) females and starting order is Man-Woman-Man-Woman. Any change in the fixed starting order leads to disqualification. It's possible to change the composition of the relay teams between the qualifying heats and the final.

- The entries must reach CMAS portal according the the procedure attached.

- World Championship will be carried out over a period of five (5) days and ten (10) sessions.

- The qualifying heats are scheduled in the morning and finals in the afternoon except 400m. IM, 800m.SF and 1500m.SF slow heats in the morning and fast heat in the afternoon. For this reason, it's requested that the national federations send to the CMAS HQ the official protocols of all national selection competitions in a delay of maximum two weeks after the competitions (in one of the three CMAS languages). Thus, times of enrollments of the swimmers will be checked for CMAS championships. If the protocols aren't transmitted in this deadline, the times of corresponding enrollments will be cancelled and the athletes will be engaged with time 59:59.59



- The organising committee guarantees to provide doping control according to the CMAS and WADA rules.





GENERAL INFORMATION

Bottle Filing

- Only compressed air without oxygen enrichment is allowed.
- For swimming pool competitions, the minimum volume of a compressed air cylinder (bottle) is liter 0,4 (zero point four liter) and liter 1 for 200-400IM.
- The maximum filling pressure for the compressed-air cylinders cannot exceed 200 bar (20 MPa).
- When a cylinder with a flat bottom is used, adding a rounded bottom, which does not exceed the radius of the cylinder, is allowed.
- All cylinders used must have passed a hydrostatic test less than two (2) years before the Championship, or even less if it is required by the local legislation.
- Each cylinder must be presented in good condition and empty during checking meeting before Championship.
- The organiser guarantees the filing of DYN & INT cylinders. For all other types teams must bring their own adaptor.

<u>Flags</u>

Each national team must bring two (2) national flags (m. 2,00 x m. 1,00).
